7 ways to make the most of your dental plan



1. Save with PPO.

Choose a network dentist to maximize your savings. These dentists have agreed to reduced fees, and you won't get charged more than your expected share of the bill.¹ Find a network dentist at deltadentalins.com:

2. Create an online account.

Check your coverage and get a cost estimate at deltadentalins.com. If you'd like an ID card, you can view or print one online. To save time and paper, update your settings to paperless. You'll receive an email when a new dental benefits statement is available.

You are responsible for any applicable deductibles, coinsurance, amounts over annual or lifetime maximums and charges for non-covered services. Non-Delta Dental dentists may bill the difference between their usual fee and Delta Dental's maximum contract allowance.
